INTERRUPTIBLE TRANSPORTATION – DELIVERY (IT-D) RESTRICTION
PROCEDURE

NGTL's filing of the above-mentioned resolution, attached to your letter dated August 13, 2004, is accepted as a filing for information. It is noted that resolution T2003-12 approves an operational procedure (Procedure) that will replace the existing Pilot Procedure and does not require any changes to interruptible service or require any tariff amendments.

The Board notes that TransCanada had previously established an objective for a collaborative review of all current pilot processes. In keeping with this objective this Pilot Procedure was reviewed and compared with current practices to ensure a workable procedure was in place should a future need arise.

The Board also notes that the Tolls, Tariffs, and Procedures Committee (TTP), predecessor to the Tolls, Tariffs, Facilities and Procedures Committee (TTFP), had adopted issue T2003-12 for discussion of an attribute of the interruptible service, on December 9, 2003. This was originally classified as a non-operational issue, as it could have resulted in changes to interruptible service. On February 4, 2004, NGTL applied to the Board for approval to commence negotiations related to this issue pursuant to the Board's Information Letter IL98-4 Revised Negotiated Settlement Guidelines. The request was approved on February 26, 2004.

The Board notes that this resolution was approved through an unopposed resolution on August 10, 2004, as an operational procedure.

NGTL is directed to distribute the filing, including the resolution, and this letter to its customers.
