APPLICATION NO. 1391441 NOVA GAS TRANSMISSION LTD. (NGTL) GAS TRANSPORTATION TARIFF (TARIFF) UPDATED TABLE OF RATES, TOLLS AND CHARGES PRESSURE/TEMPERATURE SERVICE (PT SERVICE)

NGTL's filing of an updated Table of 2005 Interim Rates, Tolls and Charges for the above-noted Tariff, Attachment 1 and Attachment 2 to your letter dated March 15, 2005, is accepted as a filing for information. It is noted that Attachment 1 incorporates a new PT Schedule of Service effective May 1, 2005; to increase operating pressures on average by 1000kPa at the January Creek interconnect located at LSD 10-27-054-14 W5M. In addition, updated schedules and charges for Rate Schedule OS have been incorporated in the table.

The Board also notes NGTL's submission that the charge for service was determined in accordance with the methodology that the Board approved in Order U2004-136. NGTL further submitted that the PT Rate is based on a fixed operating and maintenance charge of \$35.00/day. In addition, the charge for NGTL's gas requirements will be based on a PT Gas Rate of 3.0 10³m³/d and will vary with NGTL's Gas Use Price.

Notice of the Application and information requests from the Board to NGTL were issued April 5, 2005. Submissions from interested parties were requested by April 8, 2005 and responses from NGTL to the information requests were requested by April 13, 2005. The Board received responses from NGTL to the Board's information requests, but received no objections from interested parties on this matter.

The Board is satisfied that customers and interested parties, through NGTL's website and the Board's notice and information requests, were aware of the requested PT Service, and any impacts this service may have. Based on a review of the Application and the responses to the information requested, the Board believes that the requested PT Service is reasonable.

Therefore the Board directs NGTL to advise shippers and the TTFP of the acceptance of the requested PT Service via its TransCanada Alberta System website.
