NOVA GAS TRANSMISSION LTD. (NGTL) CARBON DIOXIDE (CO₂) MANAGEMENT SERVICE (CO₂ SERVICE) SEMI-ANNUAL CO₂ SERVICE REPORT APPLICATION NO. 1565462

The Alberta Utilities Commission confirms receipt of NGTL's semi-annual CO₂ service report, dated March 14, 2008. In accordance with the Terms and Conditions Respecting CO₂ Management Service, I note that the approved CO₂ service cap was established at 155 10³ m³ /day for an initial five year period after which NGTL would reduce the annual average service cap to 125 10³ m³ /day beginning January 1, 2008. Consequently, according to the Terms and Conditions set out in Decision 2002-084, the CO₂ service cap level has now ramped down to 125 10³ m³ /day subsequent to January 1, 2008. I further note NGTL's submission that since January 2008, the average aggregate amount of Excess CO₂ received by NGTL has been below the new CO₂ Service Cap level of 125 10³ m³ /day and thus remains compliant with the Terms and Conditions of the service and the directions pursuant to Decision 2002-084.
