Canadian Mainline Capacity Management Open Season

Mainline Capacity Management Open Season

Updated August 14, 2026 – This posting has been updated to reflect a change in closing date

July 24th to September 3rd (previously August 20th)

TransCanada PipeLines Limited (“TCPL”) is holding a New Capacity Open Season (NCOS) for the Canadian Mainline pipeline system from July 2, 2026 to August 27, 2026 for new Firm Transportation (“FT”) service to various delivery points east of North Bay Junction with service commencement dates offered between November 1, 2027 and November 1, 2030, or as soon as possible thereafter. The minimum term for the NCOS service offering is 15 years.

The NCOS service offering will require TCPL to increase its system capacity in the Eastern Triangle through the installation of new facilities (“Expansion Capacity”). This Capacity Management Open Season (the “Open Season”) is being conducted by TCPL to assess and potentially reduce the requirement for Expansion Capacity.

TCPL is requesting turnback offers from customers with existing FT, STS, FT-SN and EMB transportation service having receipt points of Empress, North Bay Junction (“NBJ”), Dawn, Parkway, Chippawa and Niagara that deliver to markets on the contract paths listed below (“Contracts”). Customers may offer to turnback all or a portion of their Contracts. TCPL will assess any offers of turnback to determine whether the offers will enable TCPL to reduce the requirement for the Expansion Capacity.

TCPL is also interested in other proposals that customers might have that would reduce the requirement for Expansion Capacity. Customers interested in discussing these proposals are encouraged to contact their Marketing Representative.

Request for Turnback – FT, STS, FT-SN or EMB Contract Turnback

TCPL is requesting customers who no longer require all or a portion of their FT, STS, FT-SN or EMB Contracts on or before the date when the Expansion Capacity is expected to be in-service to submit an executed Request for Turnback bid form for all or a portion of their contract demand (“Turnback Bid”). TCPL is requesting Turnback Bids with the following Contract paths:

- Contract paths with receipt points **of Empress, North Bay Junction, Dawn, Parkway, and Niagara** and delivery points of:
 - East Hereford, Napierville, Cornwall, Energir EDA, Enbridge EDA, Iroquois, KPUC EDA, Union EDA, Napanee #2 EDA, Union Parkway Belt, Enbridge CDA, Union ECDA, Union NCDA, Union SWDA, or Phillipsburg.

Any Turnback Bid submitted to TCPL shall be binding on the customer and cannot be withdrawn or amended without TCPL’s consent. Acceptance of any Turnback Bid is in TCPL’s sole discretion and will be evaluated in accordance with the Turnback Procedure in the Mainline Transportation Tariff (“Turnback Procedure”). Specifically, TCPL will reject any Turnback Bids in accordance with the

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Tariff, including Section 4.1, and will evaluate Turnback Bids based on the criteria set out in Section 4.2 of the Turnback Procedure. TCPL's acceptance of any Turnback Bid will be conditional on the executed Precedent Agreements supporting the need for the Expansion Facilities and other considerations in TCPL's sole discretion.

Open Season Evaluation and Bidding Procedures:

- Turnback Bids must be received by TCPL no later than 11:00 a.m. MST (1:00pm EST) on **September 3, 2026 (previously August 20, 2026)**.
- Turnback Bids must be submitted via the attached paper version to TCPL's Mainline Contracting Department by email to mainline_contracting@tcenergy.com
- All Turnback Bids will be reviewed and evaluated by TCPL in its sole discretion in accordance with the Turnback Procedure. TCPL is under no obligation to accept any Turnback Bid.
