RESOLUTION T2007-03 – STFT BID PROCESS SIMPLIFICATION**

Take Notice that the Alberta Energy and Utilities Board (EUB or the Board) may continue to process this application without further notice if no valid objections are received on or before **July 10, 2007**.

Particulars of the Application

NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) has filed an application dated June 13, 2007 (the Application) with the Board under Part 4 of the *Gas Utilities Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. G-5, as amended, for approval of amendments to its Tariff related to Short Term Firm Transportation (STFT).

NGTL submits that the proposed amendments will simplify the bid process for customers requesting STFT service. Currently, customers submit a fully executed Rate Schedule, Service Agreement and Schedule of Service for all STFT bids. NGTL is proposing to simplify this process by requiring all customers who intend to bid for STFT enter into an STFT Service Agreement that no longer expires automatically. Customers will then be required to submit only a one page Schedule of Service to support each subsequent bid.

NGTL notes that on June 12, 2007, the Tolls, Tariff, Facilities and Procedures Committee (TTFP) supported the proposed amendment by unopposed Resolution T2007-03. NGTL is notifying its shippers and members of the TTFP of the availability of this filing on TransCanada's Alberta System website at:

In the Application, NGTL attached TTFP Resolution T2007-03, a black-lined copy of relevant pages of the Tariff illustrating the proposed amendments, and a clean copy of the relevant sections of the Tariff incorporating the amendments.

NGTL requests the Board to render a decision on the proposed amendments by August 15, 2007 to allow for implementation effective September 1, 2007.
