

Mainline Firm Contract Renewals for November 1, 2011

A total of 2,041 TJ/d of service under Mainline firm transportation contracts was scheduled for expiry on October 31, 2011. As of May 2, 2011, TransCanada received notice from Shippers to renew 1,845 TJ/d or 90 % of the contract quantity scheduled to expire. Note that these contract quantities include firm service classes FT and STS for all paths (Long-haul and Short-haul).
